Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556) was born into a noble family in the north of Spain who was raised as a courtier and later became a soldier. He was seriously wounded in a battle in Pamplona in 1521 and upon his recovery, went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

He experienced much hardship as well as spiritual enlightenment over the years and later decided to study to become a priest. With some companions at the University of Paris, he formed the Society of Jesus in 1540. He was canonised a saint in 1622.



The **Society of Jesus** (sometimes called the Jesuits) is a Catholic religious order of men who see their mission as one of being available to go anywhere and to do anything to 'help souls'. There are currently approximately 18000 Jesuits in the world, 3 of whom are in St Joseph's Private School.
