As her role is going to be different as a headmistress, she hopes to do her utmost best for everyone in the school, especially to have a good environment for students to learn and grow in a wholesome manner.





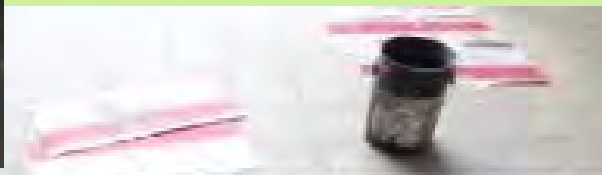
Happy Retirement
